GABA*

GABA is an important neurotransmitter in the brain and is responsible for relaxing the nervous system.

*GABA is only contained within the dog & cat version of Nutracalm.

L-Theanine

L-Theanine is an amino acid component of Green Tea and is involved in Dopamine neurotransmitter function. It has been shown to have a calming effect in dogs and cats.

L-Tryptophan

L-Tryptophan is a natural amino acid found in many proteins which is involved in the production of the hormone Serotonin and has been shown to help reduce aggression and stress.

Passiflora Incarnata

Commonly known as passion flower this extract has long been known for its ability to relax and reduce tension. Biochemical studies show that natural flavonoids are a key active ingredient and that Passiflora supports the effectiveness of GABA brain receptors which promote relaxation.

Whilst the Nutracalm ingredients are fast acting it is often beneficial to start administering the day before the desired effect is required.

* An additional 50% of the maintenance amount can be administered 2 hours before desired effect is required.
